Data privacy statement

Dear client,



The protection of your personal data is important to me. According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), I am obliged to inform you about the purpose for which I collect, store or forward data. This information sheet also tells you what rights you have with regard to data protection.

1. Responsibility for data processing

2. Purpose of data processing

Data processing is carried out on the basis of legal requirements in order to fulfill the treatment contract between you and the treating clinical psychologist and the associated obligations.

For this purpose, I process your personal data, in particular your health data. This includes master data, contact data, financial data, medical histories, diagnoses, treatment data, therapy suggestions and findings that I collect as the treating clinical psychologist and that you provide to me.

The collection of health data is a prerequisite for your treatment. If the necessary information is not provided, careful treatment cannot take place.

3. Recipients of your data

I only transfer your personal data to third parties if this is permitted by law, if it is necessary for billing purposes or in the event of emergencies, or if you have given your consent.

The recipients of your personal data are the tax office, the tax consultancy firm, the police and/or the attending emergency doctors, the legal representatives (if any) in the event of danger to yourself or others.

The transmission of your data is mainly for the purpose of invoicing the services provided or for the fulfillment of my legal tax and social security obligations. In individual cases, data may be transferred to other authorized recipients.

4. Storage of your data

I will only store your personal data for as long as is necessary to carry out the treatment. Due to legal requirements, I am obliged to keep this data for at least 10 years after completion of the treatment (see Psychologists Act 2013).

5. Your rights

You have the right to receive information about the personal data concerning you. You can also request the correction of incorrect data.

In addition, under certain conditions, you have the right to erasure of data, the right to restriction of data processing and the right to data portability.

Your data is processed on the basis of legal regulations. I only require your consent in exceptional cases. In these cases, you have the right to withdraw your consent for future processing.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent data protection authority if you believe that your personal data is being processed unlawfully.

6. Legal basis

The legal basis for the processing of your data is the GDPR in the currently valid version in conjunction with the DSG in the currently valid version.
